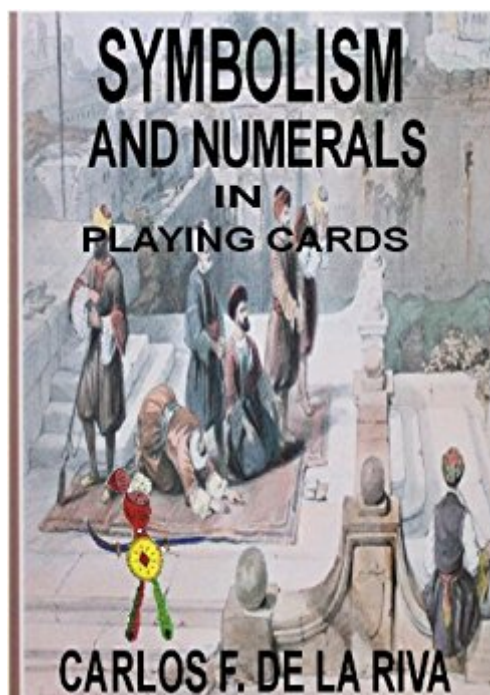

## Synopsis

Such close contact allowed the transfer of concepts and ideas to Europe and the cards with their battle symbolism and representation form prime examples of their society and behaviour. The treatment of the numbers by the Pythagorean school of thought is highlighted, to demonstrate the connection of such thinking with the numerals and formations in games and wars. The triangular nature of all game aspects is examined and compared to the religious beliefs of pagans and Christians. No such extensive analysis of these facts and connections seems to be available. Therefore the work could constitute a novelty and lead to other proposals and hypothesis to further clarify the facts.
